

# RESILIENCE QUICK-CHECK

## OUR 60 SECOND CHECK-LIST



Predicting every disruption that may arise in business is an impossible task. However it is possible to identify the most likely and most damaging incidents and to create a comprehensive plan to mitigate their effects thus improving the business resilience.

Thoroughly reviewing your business resilience may well be a complex and time-consuming undertaking. Our 60 second resilience check-list is designed primarily for people new into an organisation or who have recently assumed responsibility for Business Continuity Planning and Resilience.

Answer 10 short questions and score each question from 0 to 5 (0=Absent, 5=Perfection), you should get a quick view on your organisations resilience to a major incident.

- 1 Can you easily lay hands on a definitive statement of risk appetite?
- 2 Is there a clear operational risk model that crosses all silos?
- 3 Can you gain a quantified view of all the operational risks you face?
- 4 Do you know where the main sources of impact lie?
- 5 Do most personnel have resilience as part of their role objectives?
- 6 Do business leaders genuinely embrace resilience best practice?
- 7 Does the organisation proactively seek resilient suppliers and partners?
- 8 Does it have joined-up continuity plans that address all operating areas?
- 9 Does it measure and seek to continually improve organisational resilience?
- 10 Is all this written down and readily accessible by appropriate employees?
